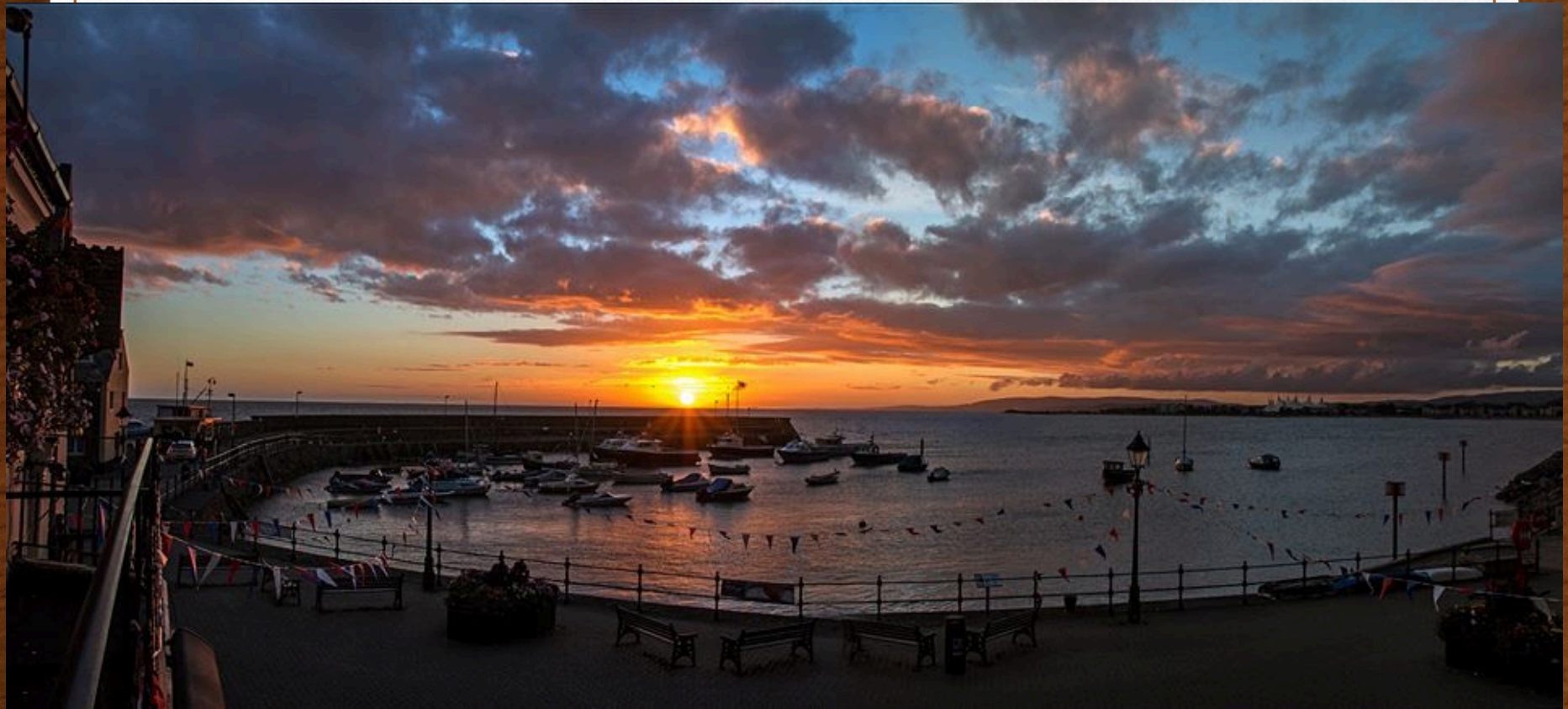




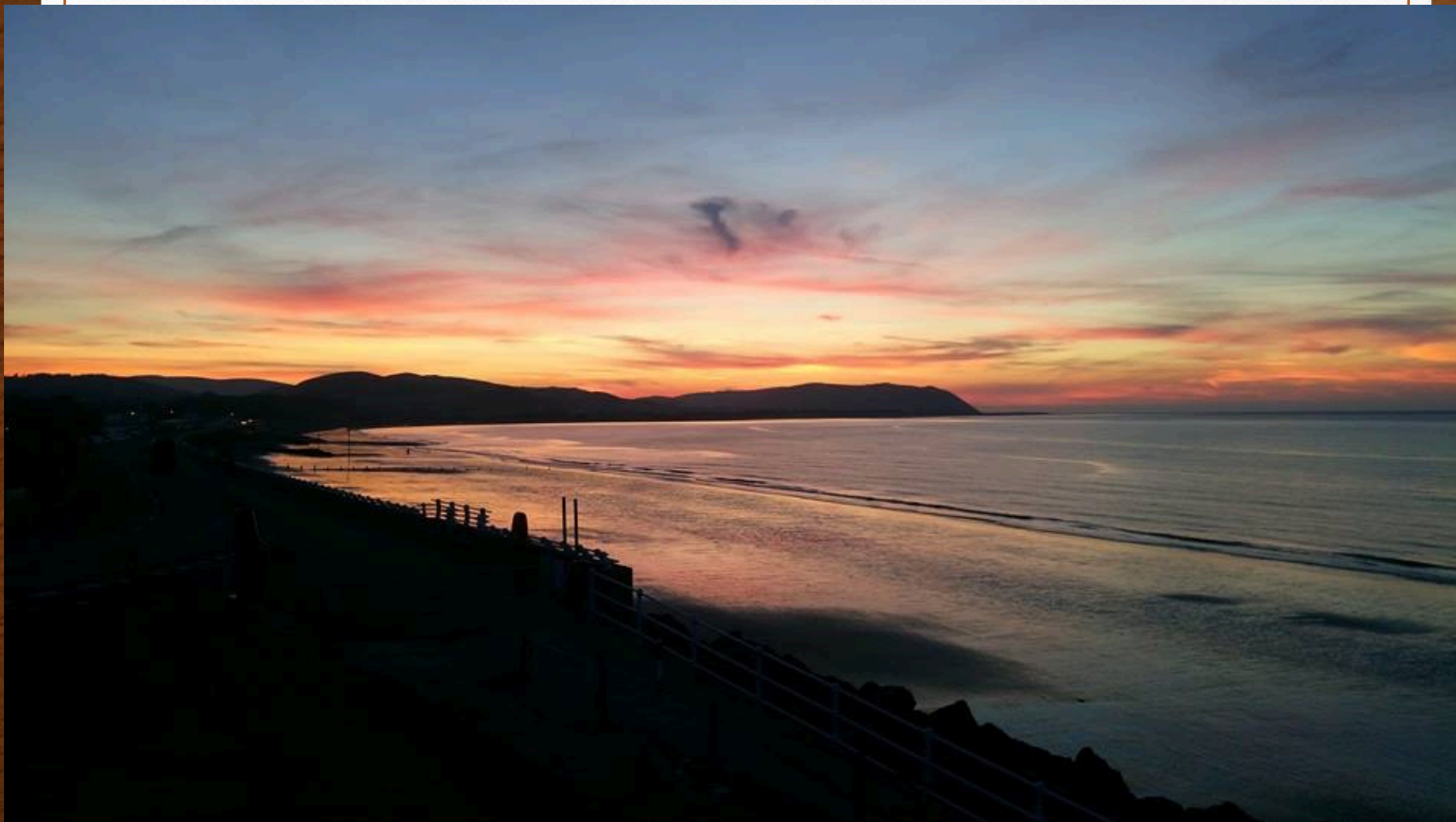
O LORD, our Lord,
