When they saw him from a distance, they could hardly recognize him; they began to weep aloud, and they tore their robes and sprinkled dust on their heads. James 1:21 Do not merely listen to the word, and so deceive yourselves, do what it says.

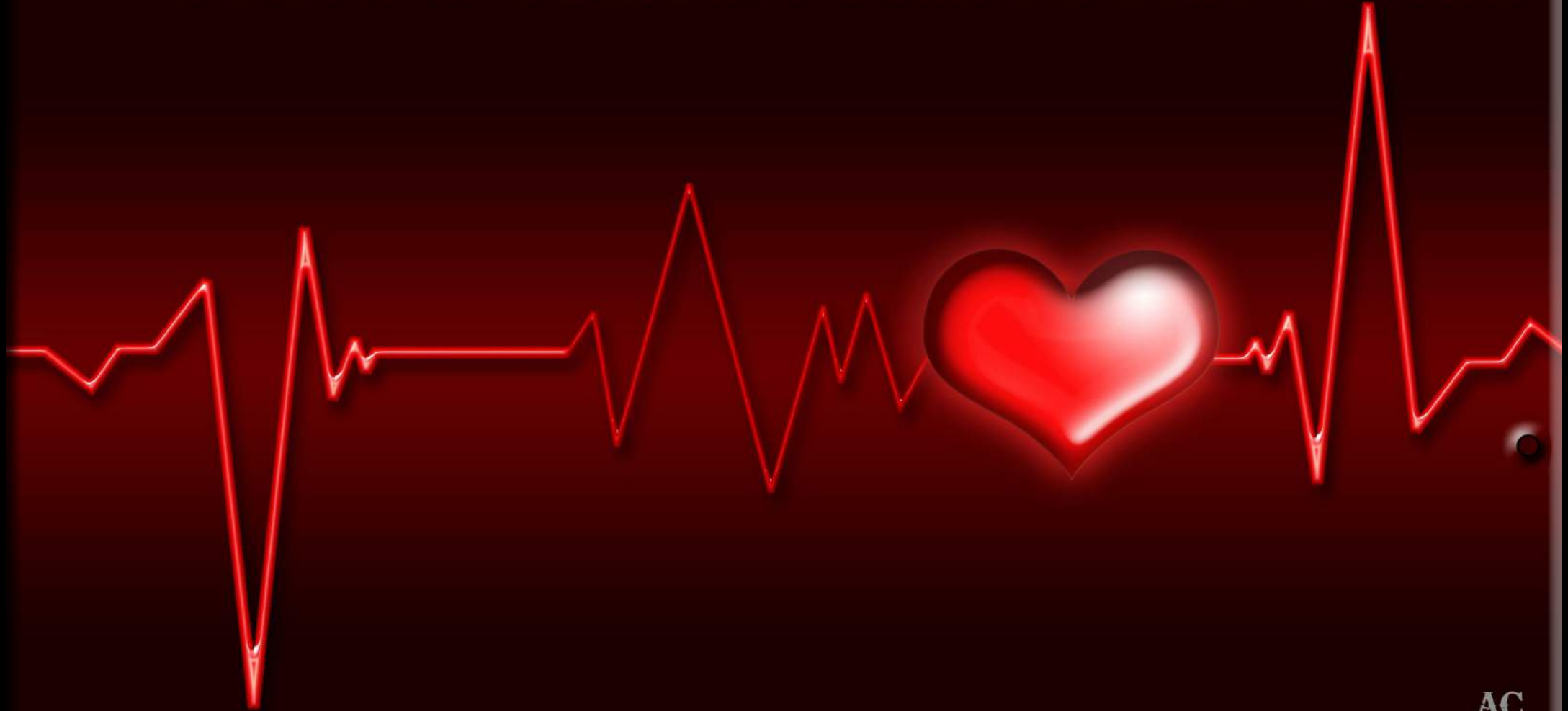
2 Corinthians 6:1 ‘Gods fellow workers’
